Start! Preparing Your Heart for the Hunt Health tips from City/County Health District

Being physically fit lowers heart disease risk even in people who have other risk factors.

Exercise and stay in shape, get a yearly physical, stop smoking. Your heart is under much more strain hunting the fields and hills than when you're on a treadmill!

Other tips include avoiding a heavy breakfast, hunt with a partner or more and let friends know your location and scheduled return. Take a cell phone with you. Also, make sensible plans for moving any game taken.
