Boat & Water Safety



- Entry Fee is \$120.00 per team. Special Projects Derby Fee is \$60.00 per team.
- Derby Caps and/or T-shirts must be ordered with your application at \$5.00 each.
- Two year Membership is required
- Dues are \$10.00/year or \$25.00/3 years and may be included with your application.

25th Annual Ice Fishing Extravaganza

It was a beautiful day for an Ice Fishing Derby. On Saturday February 16th, with the temperature near 40, 312 people took to the ice of Lake Audubon for our 25th Annual Ice Fishing Extravaganza. They each paid \$5 to search for a Perch, Walleye, or Northern Pike that would qualify them for cash prizes for the two largest fish in each category. Of the 312 entrants, almost 100 youngsters took part. In all, 51 fish were weighed: 26 Northerns, 14 Perch, and 11 Walleyes.




