- B. Northern Pike10 Lbs.
- C. Muskellunge15 Lbs.
- D. Perch1 Lbs.
- E. Smallmouth Bass2 Lbs.
- F. Largemouth Bass3 Lbs.
- G. White Bass2 Lbs.
- H. Trout2 Lbs.
- I. Sunfish or Bluegill3/4 Lbs.
- J. Crappie1 Lbs.
- K. Salmon8 Lbs.

The minimum length requirements for catch and release are:

- A. Walleye, Sauger, Saugeye20 Inches
- B. Northern, Muskellunge30 Inches
- C. Largemouth Bass16 Inches
- D. Smallmouth Bass15 Inches

Contest period is from March 15 through March 14, each year. Entries must be submitted on Dakota Anglers Catch Data Form. (Available at most bait shops.) Entries must be signed and witnessed. (Witnessed by any individual). Indicate scale used for weighing.

Photos are not required but are requested if possible. Only Dakota Anglers members and their families are eligible. Entries must be submitted within three weeks to the address on the front. All entries must be caught in North Dakota.
