At our last meeting: President Mark Stenger began the meeting. Attendance was low. Mark then mentioned how well everything went regarding the Chapter Challunge, and Brett gave a report on some of the details related to the Challunge and the fish caught. Mille Lacs is a unique fishery, with quite a few fish being caught in three feet of water or less in some areas of the lake. Rick also mentioned that we did well with our Raffle, and that after all of our expenses are paid, it didn't cost us much to host this event.

Brett talked about the International Fall Board meeting, and stated that some of the attendees flying into Fargo may need transportation to and from Detroit Lakes. If you'd be willing to volunteer for this, or to provide the use of your boat and guide service the day before the meeting, please let Brett know.

F-M member John Skarie presented three Motions that he'd like to see voted on at the Fall Board meeting. Our Chapter voted in favor of all three, and we will do everything needed to have them voted on at the Fall meeting. Here is a short "nutshell" version of each of them:

#1. Motion to not allow past Presidents to vote at the international Board meetings.

John feels that past Presidents of MI should NOT have the same power of voting as entire Chapters, and should not have the ability to have a motion tabled, as their term of office has expired.

#2. Motion to alter the voting process from a "Show of Hands" to having the International Board provide a tally sheet of eligible voters and to record how each of them voted.

It's been said that at some of these meetings, there were people voting that were actually not entitled to be. This would eliminate that and also allow each Chapter to see how the other Chapters voted.

#3. Motion to require the use of Digital cameras and bump boards instead of Judge boats in any Muskie tournament hosted by the Muskies Inc. International Board.

That one pretty much speaks for itself.

As mentioned above, all three of these were talked about at length at the August meeting, and all were in agreement that our Chapter should present these Motions at the Fall Board Meeting.

We finished the meeting by talking about Motion 7 that was tabled at the Spring Board meeting. That Motion would eliminate the International from the Members Only Fishing Contest. There is some question as to the fairness of the MOFC as it is presently set up, and most all of our members agree that they should go back to the old contest qualifications or come up with something new that would be fair to all participants.

Brian has the totals ready for the clothing order our Chapter placed. If you ordered anything from him, or if you'd like to place another order, contact him as soon as possible.

At the next meeting: We will have our "Summer Roundtable" discussion on where, when, and how fish are being caught in the area. We'll also talk about the Motions to be presented and voted on at the Fall Board Meeting.
