### TED TAKASAKI'S ANGLE ON EARLY JIGS

Last month, Ted Takasaki spoke before a full house at the Double Wood. Sitting outside was another show as Ted brought his new Lund Pro-V Glass for show and tell and so that members could see this new fishing machine.

Ted talked much about where and how to catch spring walleyes on jigs. During this time Ted typically works



7ft or less on the warm windblown shorelines. 1/16-1/4oz jigs are normally used. The size is dependent on depth and wind. On deeper or windier water you should upsize the jig. Sometimes a bigger jig is necessary to give the bait a bigger profile. Ted likes to use bright fluorescent colors in dirty water. The jigs are usually tipped with a fathead or what the available bait is. He likes plastics, but that is more to add some action and scent to the bait or change the profile.

There are a few places to key in on river and reservoir systems. One place to try is areas where river channels near shorelines. Ted likes to go up creek arms and work points, where the water is a little warmer or some weeds can be found. Also look for subtle changes, like areas where there might be a few more rocks, a hole, or open pockets of weeds.

Ted also shared many tips and answered numerous questions. When it gets windy boat control can become an issue. When this happens throw a drift sock off the transom. This will slow the boat down and also help the boat run parallel to the shoreline. Another tip to try is to use mono filament if you are missing hooksets on superlines. Opening the gap of a jig or using Max-Gap jigs can also increase the amount of hooksets. After the seminar, Ted went back to his boat to answer more questions and to allow people to look over the impressive rig.

#### **FM Walleye Club Outings UPDATE**
