



FM WALLEYES UNIVERSITY BOATING SAFETY CLASS

Tuesday, July 28th brought young boaters to the Country Inn & Suites in Fargo for FM Walleyes University Boater Safety class. Those who attended rotated between three stations; "Know Your Watercraft", "Navigation Rules" & "Safety Jeopardy" through the course of the evening. In "Know Your Watercraft" the attendees were brought to the parking lot where a boat and personal watercraft were labeled with numbers. Each student tried to identify the numbered parts of each watercraft. The instructors then went through each part and talked about it's role in the operation of the watercraft and it's importance in safe boating. "Navigation Rules" provided a video presentation on the "rules of the water" and how, by

following these rules, each watercraft operator is responsible for ensuring the safety of their watercraft and passengers. Finally, "Safety Jeopardy" provided a game setting to discuss topics like cold water immersion, the effect of alcohol & drugs on boating safety, personal floatation devices and others.

During the course of this class the students were given a solid base of boater safety information. Many of those who attended concluded the class by completing their boaters' safety certification exam through the North Dakota Game & Fish Department.



A big "Thank You" to Scott & Adam Brewer, John Dockter & Rachael Agre who provided their time and expertise, allowing this class to be a success. Without dedicated FM Walleyes volunteers the FM Walleyes University would not be possible. Additional thanks to U Motors for providing a personal watercraft for the class.


categories.



Without Cedar Crest, Fred and Karen, Denny and Joyce, Pam and Mike and a lot of others, this event could not happen. So, next year, the 1st




