

For the 10th Annual Anglers Night Thursday, March 20th



Nine plus years ago FM Walleyes came up with the idea to bring in a big name speaker and back it up with radio advertising. We needed a big name to draw the people and one name came to mind. Ted Takasaki had just won the 1998 PWT Championship in Bismarck in thrilling fashion. Many club members were present to see Ted jumping up and down as he was crowned champion. FM Walleyes is proud to bring Ted back to celebrate our Tenth Annual Anglers Night.

Ted Takasaki is a top professional angler who has competed on both the In-Fisherman Professional Walleye Trail (PWT) and the FLW Walleye Tour. He won the prestigious PWT Classic Championship in 1998 and still holds the all time tournament record for a one day limit of 5 walleyes, which weighed an amazing 53.2 pounds! In addition,

he is the President of Lindy-Little Joe tackle company, one of the nation's largest fishing tackle manufacturers. He has been featured in many national outdoor magazines and has appeared on numerous fishing television shows. Ted is considered one of America's leading walleye experts.

Doors for this event will open at 6:30 with the program starting at 7:00 on March 20th at the Doublewood Inn.

OLD BUSINESS:

-Review of last month's board meeting minutes. Motion made to approve minutes by Scott Brewer, second by Don Marty. All in favor, motion passed.

- -Club Outings, Steve Hall. Next year's outing dates/locations have been picked & are in place. Scott Stillwell mentioned the idea of possible youth sponsorship for the upcoming club outing locations. Local businesses in the towns/lakes that we will be visiting will be contacted to see if they would be willing to sponsor some youth gifts for the kids taking part in our club outings. This would give them some good exposure and also drum up some additional excitement for the kids.
- -Youth Education, Stillwells. The first run of the FM Walleyes University class went well. We received good feedback from the kids & volunteers as well. We will learn from our first attempt and make the next one even better.
- -Dinner/Dance, Tami Stillwell. This year's dinner dance was a success. We had a good turnout & even turned a profit.
- -FLW Raffle entry has been received. Drawing will be held at Angler's Night in March.
- -Sponsorship/Ad, Barry Chouinard & Chris Augustin. Tying up loose ends with sponsors/advertisers.
- -Tournament Update, Barry Chouinard. Discussion regarding the new Minnesota regulations that will add a cost to the fishing permits needed to hold our tournaments. We tabled this conversation until such time that Barry was able to gather more information so that we could make a more informed decision.
- -Angler, Young Angler Tournament. This tournament is limited to 40 teams. Lake Region Anglers club of Devils Lake ND has now made a firm commitment to the event. Permit has been applied for to hold tourney @ Devils Lake, Lakewood Ramp on Saturday, July 12th. Work is being done to firm up cash donations to hold this event. Motion was made by Barry that FM Walleye's support this event with a \$500 donation. Steve Garten seconded. Discussion followed, motion passed.

MEMBERS CAUGHT! by Steve Garten

I really don't believe this member needs any special introduction, he has been a club member for many years, and always has been a giver. Mr. Steve Hall (or commonly referred to as good ole #01 in his racing days) is our featured member. Steve and his adorable wife Mary live in Moorhead, have two fine daughters Jackie and Nikki. Both of his daughters are excellent sticks in their own right. Steve is the Service Manager at Dave's I-29 Service. He is a blast to be with in the boat and by the campfire.

The People who influenced my fishing the most? "There have been a few people who have influenced my fishing over the years, but the one person I believe got my interest in fishing started was my grandfather, Roy Larson. During the summer we



were off to different lakes about one or two times a week. Once he retired we would fish three or four times a week. My dad would sometimes go along, but was always ready to go home if we picked a slow lake.

When I look back on it, I remember what a versatile fisherman my grandfather was. We would fish for any kind of fish if the walleyes weren't biting. For the most part we used a lot of jigs, pulled them, jigged them and put them below the bobbers. We trolled with Prescott and Little Joe Spinners, even crankbaits like Lazy Ike's. Man, those were the days, no depth finders, a sixteen foot Lund with a 10 h.p. Johnson!"

Favorite Walleye fishing Tactic? "I like to fish with a jig because it can be used so many different ways. I like casting or pitching with them. You can cover a lot of ground if the fish are shallow."

Funniest Fishing Experience? "Here's the deal! I have had many stories and experiences, many of them very funny! I will share a story about my dad and I fishing. We were fishing for crappies on a little lake up by Itasca State Park. Just before ice out. I was fishing on one side of the pickup and my dad was on the other. I caught a small hammer handle northern and it got hooked up in his line, well the fight was on, back and forth, with a little fish on one side of the pickup and 'a really big fish' on the other side. All I could here was my dad yelling for me to get over there because he had the biggest fish. Once I got my little fish off and let the line go, he yelled out that his "big fish" let go, the biggest fish he had ever seen! I love those fishing tricks."

Best fishing Experience? "Over the years I have caught and landed a lot of nice fish, so catching them doesn't stand out a lot for me anymore. I have to say I really enjoy introducing people, young and old, to fishing. I love to share with them what I have learned about fishing. I love to see their interest spark when they learn of new tips to help them catch fish. Kids – take them fishing, it's something healthy that will last a lifetime for them."

I know there are a number of our club members who have benefited from Steve's suggestions on fish catching, and I know we ALL have benefited by knowing him. Thanks Steve! So who will be CAUGHT next!

Once the slate of officers and board members was presented, additional nominations were called for from the floor (three time). Since none were received, the election proceeded.


