ASK THE PROS

with Corey Heiser and Troy Morris

Unlimited who compete on the MWC Trail, will answer your questions to the best of their ability, sharing their knowledge, experience and expertise. Troy and Corey have fished the FLW, PWT, and the MWC trails over the years and are anxious to share what they have learned.

THIS MONTH'S OUESTIONS ARE:

What is your favorite body of water to fish during a tournament and while you are fishing for fun?

Troy's response- Growing up on the Missouri River system in Bismarck, fishing fast water current is by far the most fun and my favorite bodies of water to fish. The most popular options you have on these types of systems are vertical jigging, pitching jigs with live or artificial baits, trolling or casting crank baits and many more..... Also with so many places to fish on these types of systems you do not need to be crowded by boats and can fish your own spots by yourself at many times.

Corey's Response- That's truly an ironic and awesome question, because for me it is two different places. I love to fish Devils Lake on my free time. It's one of the few places in the world I can decide how I'm going to fish before I get there and typically put walleyes in the boat doing that such technique. For tournaments, I enjoy going to new places. Trying to figure out a new body of water in a weeks' time is truly a challenge. Last year, I fished different techniques at every event. That's the beauty of walleyes, they are different everywhere you go.

During the off-season, what do you do to prepare for the next year?

Corey's Response- There truly is no offseason. After the tournament season winds down, it's time to get after the year end reports, put together proposals for new sponsors, and find out what is new from the current sponsors. Most companies are starting to put together their marketing plan for the following season. That means shows, shows, and a few more shows.

Troy's Response- I will first figure out which events I am thinking about fishing next year, then shop the internet on reports for the past years fishing reports and most important are water levels for that particular body of water. Water levels are very important because it can dictate the presentation you might be using, when levels are high, fishing over trees and brush or shallow water back bays, or when levels are low and fishing main lake points and deep flats. Once I figure out where, have my lake maps purchased, studied lake maps and surfed the net on local hot spots, then figure out why they are holding fish that time of year and mark more spots on my map, then pull everything out of my boat and organize, organize and organize tackle boxes and rods.



2012 ANNUAL MEETING FEATURING JIM CARROLL

The 2012 annual club meeting brought over 100 club members together at the El Zagel Shrine to enjoy a bowl of chili and the evenings featured guest, Jim Carroll share ideas on customized ice fishing gear organization and electronics. Jim, a veteran professional angler from Minot, ND, spends a good part of the winter pursuing fish on the hard water from perch to pike and everything in between. As many club members are planning for the upcoming Lake Winnipeg Ice Fishing Excursion next month the information was both useful and timely.

Jim spoke first about the basic equipment needed for portable ice fishing organization. He compared the portable 'sled' type ice houses to a boat used on the ice. Give careful consideration to the type of fishing that will be done along with the number of people who will be fishing in the house. The market today offers sled models to accommodate from one to four anglers comfortably. Other important components include the tent material, hyfax runners, hitch and cover. Spending extra time picking out the right sled/tent combination for your fishing needs can make a huge difference in your experience out on the ice.

In further customization of an ice sled/tent Jim shared examples of how a framework can be built within the sled to create a 'deck' similar to a fishing boat. This deck can include hatches for storage of ice gear and seats to make long days on the ice more comfortable. LED lighting can brighten up the interior of any fish house. Aftermarket light strings and lanterns can be purchased to fit the needs of your individual fish house. Many of these lights can be powered from a small

From here, Jim explained, further customization can be developed to fit your fishing gear and tackle. Milk crates, plastic totes and coolers may be used for safely transporting bait, clothing, heaters and other gear. Specially designed hard sided ice rod cases or gun cases protect ice rods of any size during a rough ride across a big lake.

Jim continued by discussing the many options available for ice fishing electronics. A quick poll of those in attendance showed nearly everyone using the flasher type sonar units made by Vexilar, Marcum and Humminbird. Although Jim acknowledged the progress that flasher manufacturers have made over the past 20 years he shared that it is his belief that flashers will be obsolete in the next 5 years. He stated that LCD sonar units, particularly those manufactured by Lowrance, are now offering features which surpass those of the flasher units. Many also incorporate GPS technology and can easily be used year round in the boat as well as on the ice. Referencing a recent episode of The Next Bite, Jim shared a story of how the flat rectangular screen and recorded history features of the Lowrance Elite 5 allowed the hosts to compare their 'jigging cadences' while out on Lake Winnipeg and dial in on what was triggering the fish to bite.

The meeting concluded with a question and answer session followed by time for attendees to visit with Jim as they checked out his cusom sleds that he brought along for display.




