FM Walleyes Unlimited has been accepted as a 2011 Fresh Water Fishing Hall of Fame inductee in the 'Organization/Corporate or Government Entity' category. The Fresh Water Fishing Hall of Fame, located in Hayward, Wisconsin has been in existence since 1976 to honor those groups and individuals who have had a significant impact on the fresh water sportfishing world. This particular category honors groups that "have demonstrated and/or performed a valuable service or act to benefit fresh water sportfishing within its jurisdiction or the boundaries of its organization whether local, regional or national".





OCTOBER MEETING WITH ERIC OLSON RECAP

The October FM Walleyes unlimited, Inc. member meeting was held at El Zagel on Thursday, October 21. The people that attended were greeted outside by a couple of beautiful Ranger boats on display, compliments of Rays Marine in Moorhead and the speaker for the evening. When the meeting started, there were a few business items to discuss and then the speaker was introduced. Eric Olson, FLW Walleye Tour Pro, started the seminar by making every person in the room stand up, raise their right hand, and promise not to share his secrets. Even though he was joking (I think), there were plenty of secrets that were given out to those in attendance.

During the evening, Eric spoke about the tactics and tricks he used to win the 2010 Lake Oahe FLW Tour event. As in many lakes, wind is a large factor on fish location in Lake Oahe. According to Eric, to fish this lake effectively, you need to figure out that the wind is doing to all the underwater structure and fish accordingly. Things to look for are points, breaks, trees, and/or suspended bait. He mentioned that breaking the lake up into small sections really helps to make a large lake like Oahe more manageable. It also helps to set up a "milk run" of spots for when the tournament starts.

Eric spent a lot of time discussing tips on how to effectively use the "Slow Death" rig. This rig has become very popular in the past few years and has won many tournaments. It was his weapon of choice for this event. A Slow Death rig is a specially bent hook with a 3 to 4 ft leader that is pulled behind a bouncer. One half night crawlers is always the bait of choice with slow death rigs. Many people have used and experimented with this type if rig with mixed results, but Eric gave some very good tips to ensure success. Eric says that the night crawler should "Roll" instead of just spinning in tight circles. The "Roll" is the triggering mechanism. The bait can be moved up and down on the hook to get the desired "Roll". Optimum speed is .8 to .9 mph.

To finish the meeting, Eric challenged everyone to think different, be different and to try different things that are a little out of your comfort zone. He said one of the best ways to grow as an angler is to use your weakest presentation for 1 entire year. After that year, it just may be your strongest presentation. Get out of the rut, and try something new, and stick with it.

Devils Lake, ND – Johnnie Candle and Dave Noble have been crowned the World Walleye Champions. The team won the Masters Walleye Circuit World Walleye Championship by beating 27 other teams on the Mississippi River near Prairie Du Chien, WI October 14, 15, and 16.

The team not only had to beat the best anglers in competitive fishing, but had to contend with a flooded Mississippi River. Southern Minnesota and Northern Wisconsin had been belted with up to 10 inches of rain and the river was running high, creating some very difficult fishing.

"Our first two days on the river were very uneventful," cites Noble. "We didn't catch anything at all." By the third day of pre-fishing things started to look up. Two fish that day followed by three fish the next lead the team to the winning spot.

"On the final day of pre-fishing, we decided to check one more area. We had driven by it several times, but the falling water made it seem obvious this time. On Dave's first cast he caught a nice 18 incher, then two casts later got another one near that size. We knew where we were starting, but had no idea the potential of the spot." explained Candle.

Day one brought a limit by 8:40 am, day two by 9:20. Day three took a little longer but the team filled out by 12:30. As it ended up, Candle on Noble were one of only two teams that weighed a 15 fish tournament limit for the three days. Their 34.95 pounds bested second place by nearly 8 pounds to secure the victory and the title of World Walleye Champions.



The team fished a rock jetty covered by 5 to 6 feet of water that protected a public boat ramp. In normal conditions this spot would have been high and dry, but with the flood waters it fished as a typical Mississippi River wing dam. Casting #5 Berkley Flicker Shads and #7 Rapala Shad Raps proved to be the winning combination. The colors of choice were custom painted lures from Dutch Fork Custom Tackle in pink and pearl and a new color called Krome Krappie.

"A big key to our presentation," mentions Candle, "is the fact that we changed lines as the water fell. If our lures didn't contact the rocks just right, we didn't get bit. On day one the water was deeper and we use 6/2 Berkley FireLine to get to the rocks. By day three, we had to go to 14/6 FireLine to keep the lures form diving too deep."

Noble admitted that another factor in the win was the Spot Lock feature on Candle's MinnKota Terrova. "We never touched the trolling motor. For three days Johnnie would set the spot lock and never touched the motor again. It kept his 20 foot Crestliner right where we wanted to be regardless of wind or river currents." The win netted them \$25,000 and a pair of 14k gold rings to commemorate the accomplishment.

In the past two seasons as team mates, Johnnie and Dave have racked up some good results. They have three top ten finishes, been named Cabela's All Americans, earned two championship births and won the 2010 World Walleye Championship.

Dave Noble resides in Dixon, IL with his wife Anne, two sons Seiler and Elliot and a step son Jacob. He is a graduate of Waseca High School in Waseca, MN. Noble manages a Wal-Mart distribution center in Sterling, IL. He enjoys angling of all types. He has been tournament angling for the past two seasons.

Johnnie Candle resides in Devils Lake, ND with Bobbi Lunday and her 4 daughters Anja, Bailey, Caitlin and Dru Lunday. He is a graduate of Southeast High School in Ravenna, Ohio as well as the University of Akron, Ohio. He has been a professional angler for 18 years. He is sponsored by Scheels Sporting Goods Stores, Crestliner Boats, Mercury Outboards, MinnKota, Humminbird, Navionics, Berkley, Fenwick, Abu, Rapala, Costa Del Mar, Fin-Tech, Today's Tackle, Dutch Fork Custom Lures, Mack's Lures, and the Lake Region State College in Devils Lake, ND.

LONG TIME MEMBER STILL ENJOYS GETTING OUT FOR SOME FALL FISHING




