

Legislation Summary for the week of Feb. 26-March 2, 2007

<u>SB 2019</u> Parks & Recreation Appropriations; heard by the House Education & Environment Appropriation Committee on Monday, Feb 26, 2007 in the Sakakawea Room at 2:15 PM. (Appropriation/funding for the marina at Fort Stevenson State Park.) I attended the hearing but didn't think it necessary to testify as I testified during the ND G&F appropriations hearing

<u>HB 1513</u> Relating to an emergency municipal water grant (loan) program; and to provide an appropriation. Heard by the Senate Natural Resource Committee in the Fort Lincoln Room on Thursday, March 1, 2007 at 10:30 AM. Testified in favor of the bill. There was a lot of positive testimony given by various organizations and individuals. No vote has been taken by the committee.

HCR 3044 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study how the state might pursue additional uses of Lake Sakakawea & Missouri River waters for such beneficial purposes as domestic & industrial uses, recreation, fish & wildlife, & irrigation, & how the state, to enhance its use of the lake and river, might promote congressional review of the 1944 Flood Control Act & a reexamination by the Corp of Engineers on the way in which it manages the Missouri River system. Heard Thursday, 3/1/07 Senate Natural Resources Committee in Fort Lincoln Room at 10:45 AM. Testified in favor of the concurrent resolution as well as many other individual and organizations. Friday, March 2, 2007, the Senate declared adopted and the title agreed to on a voice vote.

<u>SCR 4016</u> Urging Congress to direct the US Corps of Engineers to address and rectify the problems caused by sediment in the Missouri River main stem reservoirs. Heard Friday, 3/2/07, House Natural Resources Committee in the Pioneer Room at 9:00 AM. Presented written testimony. The concurrent resolution was not acted upon.
