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

LAKE OAHE UPDATE RYNEE

It is more than a year since Reel & Rec., Voices From Lake Oahe, and the Good Sams Club joined forces to try to get to get some recreational development along the east bank of Lake Oahe. Some development has happened, but not as much as one would expect. Thru Senator Dorgan's office we were able to get the channel at Hazelton boat dock dredged late last fall in time for the fall bite. The COE with their funds installed electricity for one pad. According to the COE, they will install five more sites in the spring.

The three clubs have different # one projects. The Reel & Rec will focus on trying to get the Hazelton Boat Landing moved one half mile south. Until the boat landing gets moved to the new location, we will work with the COE to continue dredging the channel way as needed.

Good Sams Club is interested in modernizing the Hazelton campground. They would like to have running water, modern toilet facilities, and electricity. Reel & Rec and VFLO will provide assistance to have this accomplished.

VFLO number one project is to have a water impoundment at Beaver Bay east of ND 1804. If this would happen, think about the good fishing one could have. This impoundment would be similar to Lake Audubon. This project has the blessing of the Emmons County Water Board, but not the Emmons County Commissioners. Much work will be needed to make this a reality. It could happen if you fishermen demand it.

This coming year the Reel & Rec Oahe Boatlanding Committee will work with offices of the Governor and Senator Dorgan to try to resolve the issues at Hazelton Boatlanding.

Ron Kraft has worked hard to accomplish the above items. He needs a pat on the back and some support to make these things happen. Would you!

Remember to go to the steak fry on January 18th, 2007. Bob Valeu, from Senator Dorgans office will be there to give us a pep talk on plans for Oahe. Terry Steinwand will be on hand to answer any questions you may have on fishing issues. We will have a special guest who has helped Reel & Rec in the past.
