#### DEAN HILDEBRAND PARK

After Dean Hildebrand retired from the North Dakota Game & Fished Department, (ND G & F) he and I fished frequently. The subject of the Prison Property came up frequently as what should happen to the riverfront in the future should it change uses. Dean's vision was to make it into a park area for people to enjoy the outdoors. His vision was to build a boatlanding, provide area for bank fishing and leave the rest natural.

The last legislative session there was talk of selling this parcel of land to help pay for a new penitentiary. There are groups of people now forming to have a hand on the land use of this area. Some are in favor of selling the entire chunk for development; others would like a variation of leaving as is to partial and full development.

Here are my feelings about this area if it should change uses. With Sibley Park close by, that boatlanding should be closed as it is not useable most of the time. Sibley Camping and playground use should continue.

The river front erosion should be stabilized; river channel should be cleaned of debris. A place should be provided for bank fishing. A new boatlanding should be built on the prison land. The treed river front should be left primitive for nature lovers. Hunting on some of the land should be allowed to keep animal populations in check.

If this area is allowed to develop into housing it will be lost forever for the average citizen to view and use the river. One needs to go to the public areas that are along the Missouri River between Bismarck/Mandan that allows public access to see the
